# Main differences in the rules for 2017

- No cuts (semi-final and final removed)
- All competitors are doing 8 rounds
- Result calculation in round 6 and
   7 is sum of the best 4 jumps
- Result calculation in round 8 is sum of the best 5 jumps
- Max n# of competitors per exit pass is 6
- Max exit altitude for a valid jump is 13.500 ft above the ground

### Safety advice:

It is recommended to have at least 200 jumps and FF1 or TR3 or at least be able to steep angle fly on heading. Email Mikey if you're not sure if you're experienced enough to compete.

Equipment requirements: Rigs should be on the safer side of FF friendly. No exposed bridle. Tight BOC pocket. Hacky deployment is not recommended (ff pad is better). Nice secure reserve and cutaway handles. Riser covers must stay closed (standard vector magnetic riser covers are not suitable, it is possible to upgrade with a third pair of magnets). Two audible altimeters. Full-face helmet is recommended but not mandatory.

Clothing recommendations: FF suit or FF trousers with tight top is good. Jeans/trousers are also fine.
